


Open brief tegen privatisering van Gentse publieke grond

21 oktober 2019

Steuncomité De Hongerige Stad

Gent verkoopt onverminderd landbouwgrond, zonder ook maar enige vorm van publiek overleg, hekelen tientallen Gentse landbouw- en andere organisaties, samen met burgers. Ze eisen een moratorium op de verkoop van publieke grond door stad en OCMW Gent. Ze roepen de stad ook op om eerst en vooral duidelijk in kaart te brengen welke gronden ze bezit, om vervolgens met het publiek te overleggen over hoe ze zullen worden ingezet in het algemeen belang.

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Main goals of the *Stadsacademie*

- to experiment with new ways of knowledge production: transdisciplinary, reflexive, student-led,... processes
- to explore and to impact upon sustainability issues in Ghent
- to become an "*incubator and international reference for transdisciplinary research and education on urban sustainability problems*"



Coordination


- One overall coordinator (paid by UGent)
- Day-to-day management: coordinator + 3 engaged professors
- Steering group: 10 to 15 professors, postdocs, PhDs,... and 5 to 8 non-academic actors (policy makers from the city of Ghent)







Some reflections

- **Preparation phase:** 1 year and an organic process is needed.
- The 'silo' structure of our university does not work in favor of an atelier → Problems to recruit students.
- Intensive collective focus in the first semester \rightarrow some students ran into problems to finalise their thesis in time.
- 'Multiperspectivism' is perceived as enriching.
- The atelier functions as 'a socially safe space'.
- Adequate valorisation remains the greatest challenge.
