# Origins of cooperation

Change in collaboration

- Invest in larger projects with 'real' collaboration between key staff
- Allows for wider engagement in local issues: more stakeholders, build-up of capacity building

### **Making City**



Pursue so called 'Positive Energy Districts', with:

- Technical solutions (e.g. renewables, insulation, smart metering)

  - New City Vision for 2050
  - Novel tool development

# **Network building**

Making City as an example and catalyst for build-up of local network of expertise and collaboration

#### For Faculty of Spatial Sciences:

- 2ISECAP (H2020) on Local Energy Coalitions
- Direct impact on and feedback from practice
- New and intensified collaborations with other parties
- Ambition to study tools for 'real empowerment'





### **Empowerment**

Increasing energy prices (EU 2020, Luteijn 2021) and risk of a (large) group being 'left behind'

- No roof (for PV)
- Low income / low capital
- No ownership (private rent especially)
- Energy poverty

But also: real involvement in decisions and ownership

- Societal movement
- Collective ownership
- Transactional services
- Boundary spanning

Bottum-up community building versus professional projects and partnership



### Lessons
