

# English – Online course Fall 2022

<b>About the course</b>	<p>Even after years of studying English, do you feel that you cannot express yourself appropriately enough, fluently enough, or accurately enough? To put it simply, express yourself in a way you would be happy with?</p> <p>Are you worried your communication partner won't understand you because of the mistakes you might make? That you won't be able to present yourself the way you would in your native language? In our course, we will teach you some immediately-applicable strategies that can help you solve these problems and, at the same time, introduce you to long-term strategies, through which you can work systematically on developing your communicative competence.</p>
<b>Course content</b>	<p>At the beginning of the course, students will be introduced to strategies through which they will be able to improve their fluency and accuracy in oral communication in English. They will practise these skills through spontaneous, semi-planned, and planned communication events in work or study contexts that are relevant to them. In the next phase of the course, students will learn to express themselves at different levels of formality, reflecting on the appropriateness of expression in various situations.</p>
<b>Learning Outcomes</b>	<p>After this course, students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) be familiarized with immediately-applicable strategies that can help them improve their fluency in spoken English;</li> <li>b) be familiarized with long-term strategies to help them improve their fluency and their communicative competence in general;</li> <li>c) be able to use strategies to develop accuracy in speaking;</li> <li>d) be able to use linguistic devices in conversations at different levels of formality, reflecting on the appropriateness of expression in various situations within the study and work contexts.</li> </ul>
