About the course	Our English courses are part of the practical language courses that we offer. In the courses we focus on fluent, successful and accurate communication and the skills that play a crucial role to make that happen (speaking, reading, listening, writing).
Course content	<p>Level 4 (B1+)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Listening skills: Authentic materials enable you to learn how to understand and process spoken English more fluently. You will also become more familiar with more complicated grammatical structures. ▪ Speaking skills: Improving the speaking skills is an important objective of this course. Role-plays, class discussions and individual speaking assignments enable the participants to speak as much as possible. ▪ Reading skills: You will familiarise yourself further with authentic text materials. ▪ Writing skills: Practical assignments will give you the opportunity to practice grammatical items and structures in realistic contexts. <p>Level 5 (B2)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Listening skills: You will familiarise yourself further with authentic audio fragments. ▪ Speaking skills: You will learn to express yourself fluently and spontaneously about different topics without having to search for specific words. ▪ Reading skills: You will familiarise yourself further with longer authentic text materials. ▪ Specific grammar topics: The basic principles of the English grammar (e.g. relative clauses, gerund vs. to-infinitive) will be revised and further explored.
