

Spanish language online courses 2022-2023

<p>About the courses</p>	<p>The courses are designed so that students acquire the necessary language skills and competencies in Spanish. During these online courses, interaction is the center of the learning process providing a safe environment in which to use the new language elements. <p>Courses content</p>	<p>A) Functional and formal contents</p> <p>This block includes the functional and grammatical contents of the unit. Throughout it, the student performs a series of practical tasks of these linguistic forms in situations of interaction within the classroom.</p> <p>B) Reading and listening comprehension</p> <p>In this second section, models of texts and / or spoken language samples are presented that contextualize the contents studied in the first block and that allow students to develop different comprehension strategies.</p> <p>C) Written expression and interaction</p> <p>Written expression will allow students to work, practice and elaborate different types of written texts and / or discursive samples appropriate to their level and based on the functional and formal contents seen in the first part of the session.</p> <p>D) Oral expression and interaction</p> <p>Each unit is completed with this section where the students, through a series of communicative tasks such as expositions, debates, presentations..., have the opportunity to practice the oral use of the language in a group.</p>
<p>Learning Outcomes</p>	<p>After active engagement in the course, students are expected to be able:</p> <p>A) Beginner</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce the vocabulary and the precise structures to allow the student a basic communication about himself and the world that surrounds him/her. • Talk / Write about oneself and about others in terms of personal life: identification, habits and customs, daily routine, tastes and preferences. Regular and irregular presents. Verb like.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask for and give instructions in different situations: in space, in the use of machines or in habitual actions. <p>B) Intermediate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Expand vocabulary and develop structures to improve communication about your closest reality. Review of regular and irregular presents. • Review and expand the structures to talk about their own life and that of others, in the present and past. Develop the student's communication skills when expressing instructions and / or advice. • Know and use some idiomatic expressions in appropriate contexts. <p>C) Advanced</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review and expand the knowledge about the indicative tenses: special uses of the present. Habitual actions, actions in the present moment, universal truths, present with future value, present with past value, express orders. • Review and contrast past indicative tenses: recent actions, specific actions in the past, habitual actions in the past, previous actions to past ones. • Develop the ability to express feelings, opinions, complaints, wishes, hypotheses using appropriate idiomatic expressions. • Develop the ability to express oneself orally and in writing by properly using the discourse connectors.

Assessment	<p>CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. PARTICIPATION: 3 points 2. WRITING SKILLS: 2 points 3. FINAL EXAM: 5 points <p>To be evaluated continuously, students must attend 85% of the teaching hours in addition to exceeding 50% in each of the 3 evaluation elements.</p> <p>FINAL ASSESSMENT</p> <p>Students who do not have active attendance and participation of 85% must take a final exam of all content.</p> <p>The final result will be 100% of the grade, but to be PASSED you must exceed 50% in each of the evaluated competencies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ LISTENING: 2,5 points ▪ READING: 2,5 points ▪ WRITING: 2,5 points ▪ SPEAKING: 2,5 points

ECTS	<p>Certificate:</p> <p>Once each course has finished, the University of the Basque Country (UPV/EHU) will issue a CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE and PROGRESS to the students who have passed the evaluation of these courses. The issue of this certificate is conditional to passing the course in which students have enrolled. No other certificate will be issued except this one.</p> <p>Enrolment in the courses is mandatory and an indispensable condition for obtaining the certificate.</p> <p>The certificates issued by the UPV/EHU cannot be considered as an official proficiency test, having only a purely academic value. That is, they are valid to justify the grades and credits in order to get the courses' credits validated by the home university.</p> <p>Credits:</p> <p>The certificate for each course will include a numerical mark (from 5 to 10) and the level of each student according to ability (listening, reading, spoken and written comprehension) based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR: A1-A2, B1-B2, C1-C2). Likewise, the credits corresponding to each course will be listed:</p> <p>Intensive Spanish course: 4.5 credits. Autumn and spring courses: 6 credits (both the autumn and spring course).</p>
